



Uniform Policy

Mount Gambier North Primary School, the Governing Council, Principal, Staff and Student Leaders support our Uniform Policy. Completing the application to enrol at Mount Gambier North Primary School is taken as acceptance of the Uniform Policy.

Purpose

We believe that wearing a school uniform helps students identify with the school, fosters a sense of community, and prevents discrimination, unhealthy competition, and conflicts at home.

PANTS	Navy or black tracksuit pants Blue or black denim Jeans Navy or black leggings
SHORTS	Navy, black or denim shorts (No shorter than mid length, measured by where the individual's fingertips meet the thigh)
DRESSES / SKIRTS	Navy or black skirts (No shorter than mid length, measured by where the individual's fingertips meet the thigh) Blue and white checked dresses
T-SHIRTS	Mount Gambier North Primary School polo shirt Plain navy-blue polo shirt Polo shirts may be worn with white or navy long sleeves underneath
JUMPERS	Mount Gambier North Primary School jumper Plain navy-blue jumper Year 6 graduating jumper *Hooded jumpers are not suitable
FOOTWEAR	Comfortable closed in shoes *Thongs, high heels, gumboots and slip on shoes are not suitable
HATS	In line with the Sun Smart School Policy, it is a requirement for students to wear broad brimmed, bucket style or legionnaires hat in terms 1, 3 & 4. Navy beanies may be worn outside in the cooler months
JEWELLERY & ACCESSORIES	Watches, single necklaces; locket or chain and bracelets Earrings; studs or sleepers *Dangling or excessive jewellery is not suitable *Make up is not suitable *For safety reasons children may be asked to remove jewellery when playing sport or working with certain equipment.

Excursions and Special Occasions

It is an expectation of our school that students adhere to the Dress Code Policy while on school excursions and during special occasions.

Additional Notes

The following uniform pieces are available from our Front Office, Eftpos is available.

Polo Shirts (Navy with logo) - \$30

Jumpers (Navy with logo) - \$35

Hats (Navy broad brimmed) - \$8

It is recognised that there are times when children may not be able to wear their school uniform. However, children must bring an explanatory note from their parents informing the school of the reason why this is so.

Students who come to school not wearing school uniform, without a note, will be asked to go to the front office and wear clean, spare uniform for the school day.

Parents are invited to contact the school should problems arise regarding outfitting students in school uniforms. Any parent experiencing financial difficulty may apply for financial help.

New students to the school will be asked to wear a uniform as similar as possible to our uniform until they can purchase the one worn by the Mount Gambier North Primary School students.
